Computer Station Time Limit

The Sausalito Public Library offers internet access and popular software applications to its patrons at desktop computers in the library. In order to ensure that computer time is available to a large number of library users, library patrons are asked to limit their total usage to 3 hours per day and to use one computer station at a time. The 3-hour time limit applies to usage at a single sitting (or “standing” at a standing station) or spread out over the course of a day. The limit likewise applies to computer use at a single station or at multiple stations. This limit does not apply to the library’s catalog computers, nor does it apply to people who bring their own devices to the library. Exceptions may be made if the library is not busy.
