

Transportation options in Sausalito and Marin County for older adults

Below are transportation options for local residents:

[CARSS](#) Call a Ride for Sausalito Seniors (Sausalito residents only)

With just one phone call, seniors 60 and older can request a FREE ride anywhere within Sausalito, the floating homes community and Marin City, Monday through Friday 10am to 2pm. Rides are provided by vetted volunteers in their own cars. Become a volunteer or member: Call 415-944-5474 for an application. This is a City of Sausalito Age-Friendly Program managed by Sausalito Village.

[SAUSALITO VILLAGE](#) (94965 residents only)

Sausalito Village is a non profit membership group that helps older residents stay in their own home as long as possible through a diverse range of volunteer services and programs including transportation to medical appointments in Marin and San Francisco as well as group trips to grocery stores. Membership is open to anyone living in 94965. Low income waivers are available. Become a volunteer or member: Call 415-332-3325 for an application. If you are outside of Sausalito you can contact Marin Villages at 415-457-4633.

Below are transportation options available countywide:

[CATCH A RIDE](#)

Riders enrolled in Catch-A-Ride have the ability to schedule rides with either Uber through an app on the phone or through Northbay Taxi by a phone call. Riders pay the first \$5, the next \$20 is free but anything after \$25 is paid by the rider. Sample: Ride is \$40, Rider pays \$20 (\$40 - \$20=\$20). Recipients receive 30 vouchers for \$20 per quarter.

To be eligible for Catch-A-Ride you must be a Marin resident and meet the following criteria:

Age 65 and older

Rides must either originate or end in Marin or be within Marin

[ADA PARATRANSIT](#)

This wheelchair accessible van transportation is for persons who are unable to ride public fixed route transportation due to physical or mental conditions. Rides are available in Marin County but also to neighboring counties. There is a nominal fee. The application also requires medical information completed by your doctor.

[MARIN ACCESS VOLUNTEER DRIVER](#)

Marin Transit's STAR and TRIP programs are mileage reimbursement programs for volunteer drivers even if they are friends or neighbors. To qualify, riders must be 65+ or

persons who qualify for paratransit and the driver must complete an application with Marin Access. There are monthly reimbursement limits.

CAREPOOL

Carepool provides FREE Volunteer Rides to Medical Appointments or Grocery Shopping for Marin County residents 65 or older and for people with disabilities. Extra support, such as unloading groceries for riders, walking riders into their doctor's appointment, and waiting for them until the appointment ends.
